**AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J.(ORAL)**

By this petition, FIR No.5 dated 01.01.2008, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Bathinda Kotwali, District Bathinda, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471, 506, 120-B IPC, is sought to be quashed, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners-accused and respondent no. 2, i.e. the complainant.

Pursuant to the order dated 17.05.2017, the report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda, has been received, stating therein that the statements of the complainant (respondent no.2) Gurmail Singh, as also that of the petitioners (accused) Balkaur Singh, Jalour Singh, Jeet Singh and Gurjant Singh, were recorded before that Court in terms of the compromise reached between them.

compromise appears to be genuine and voluntary.

Learned State counsel also has not been able to show any other criminal case registered against the petitioners.

Consequently, the matter having been amicably resolved between the parties in which the allegation was that the petitioners had defrauded the complainant, who is stated to be a relative of the petitioners, I see no purpose in continuing with criminal proceedings against the petitioners.

Therefore, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR, no. No.5 dated 01.01.2008, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Bathinda Kotwali, District Bathinda, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471, 506, 120-B IPC, along with all proceedings arising therefrom, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
