The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.118 dated 15.03.2018 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 506, 427, 379-B IPC (Sections 325, 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Old Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that although the petitioner was named in the FIR, however, the injuries attributed to him are simple in nature. Counsel further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 19.03.2018.

Learned State Counsel being instructed by ASI Subhash Chand, does not dispute that the petitioner is in custody since 19.03.2018 or the fact that the injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits

of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner

shall be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
