Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.20 dated 13.01.2018, registered under Sections 148, 149, 285, 323, 325, 326, 427, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation; nothing has to be recovered from them, therefore, they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 01.05.2018, passed by this Court, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
