On 30.04.2018, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Prayer in this petition is for quashing of order dated 24.08.2018 (Annexure P2) passed by the trial Court in a complaint filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, by respondent No.2, vide which, the petitioner was declared a proclaimed person.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was never served with the summons of the case and while declaring the petitioner as proclaimed person, proper procedure has not been followed under Section 82 Cr.P.C.

Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and face the trial.

Notice of motion for 13.08.2018.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on 07.05.2018 and the trial

Court will release the petitioner on interim bail subject to payment of costs of ₹2,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Palwal.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court on 07.05.2018 and furnished the bail/surety bonds. Counsel further submits that the petitioner has been released on interim bail by the trial Court.

Photocopy of the order is placed on record.

In view of the same, this petition is disposed of. Order dated 30.04.2018 is confirmed.
