Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that by considering the custody of the petitioner and stage of the trial, the petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail vide order dated 20.3.2018. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner has never misused the concession of interim bail, out of total 12 prosecution witnesses, only 6 have been examined and alleged recovery is marginally more than the commercial quantity.

Learned State counsel has also not disputed the stage of trial and the bail granted in the cases mentioned in order dated 20.3.2018.

In view of the above, order dated 20.3.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute during pendency of the trial.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
