Petitioners seek issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents to protect their lives and personal liberties from being invaded at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that on 01.04.2018, private respondents gave beatings to petitioner No.2. A complaint was filed before the police but no action was taken. Thereafter, representation was filed before respondent No.2 on 06.04.2018 which is still under consideration.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioners are being harassed by the police and now they feel reasonable apprehension that they may be eliminated by the private

respondents in collusion with police.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing any reply, as no order prejudicial to the interest of either party is being passed.

At this stage, without embarking upon merits of the case, it would be appropriate to ask respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the grievance of the petitioners and pass appropriate order in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.
