JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking bail in FIR No.603 dated 17.08.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal.

Contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case. The petitioner himself was an investor and has been wrongly alleged to be a Director of the company. Co-accused Sunil has already been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court. The petitioner is in custody since 02.02.2016.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the offence committed by the petitioner is serious in nature. The petitioner along with co-accused, duped a number of people and obtained approximately Rupees one crore and twenty five lakh.

Heard.

This is the sixth bail petition moved by the petitioner. Learned

counsel has not been able to cite any fresh favourable circumstance. The trial is in progress. This Court is of the considered opinion that in case, the petitioner is admitted to bail, there is every likelihood that he may tamper with the evidence and/or influence the witnesses. Therefore, no case for grant of bail is made out.

Along with the main petition, the petitioner has also moved an application bearing CRM No.20050 of 2018, for grant of interim bail for a period of eight weeks on medical grounds.

In response to the notice of motion order, short affidavit of DSP, Karnal has been filed in the Court, which is taken on record. As per the medical certificate issued by the Medical Officer, District Prison, Karnal, appended with the affidavit as Annexure R-1, the general condition of the petitioner is stable and his vitals are within normal range. Thus, the prayer for grant of interim bail is also declined.

Dismissed.
