The present petition has been filed seeking protection of life and liberty as the petitioners fear that respondents No.5 to 8 (parents and other relations of petitioner No.1) will cause them bodily harm as their marriage has been performed against their wishes.

2. Petitioners No. 1 is major whereas petitioner No.2 is stated to be 20 years of age and is under marriageable age. Documents annexures P-1 to P-5, placed on record, have been perused.

3. In view of above, without commenting upon the validity of the marriage, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to ensure that life and liberty of the petitioners be protected by providing them adequate protection after carrying out a threat assessment and as and when deemed appropriate. The representation (Annexure-5) already made as well as the facts mentioned in this petition shall be kept in mind by him.

4. The petition is accordingly disposed of.
