AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is being time and again called by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar-respondent No.3 and is made to sit for the whole day with an intention to harass and humiliate the petitioner at the behest of respondents 7 and 8. He contends that the petitioner has nothing to do with the grievance of respondents 7 and 8. Petitioner is not averse to join the inquiry/investigation in the case, provided he is given proper notice by respondent No.3. He prays that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to give a proper notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. if the petitioner is required for inquiry in the matter.

Having considered the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case and commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with direction to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar-respondent No.3, to give a proper notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. in case the petitioner is required for inquiry.
