ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 47 dated 30.03.2017, registered under Sections 323, 376, 306 IPC, Women Police Station Ambala, District Ambala.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 27.04.2017 and there is no suicide note and no DNA test was carried out and six witnesses have already been examined and the trial is taking time. It was urged that the case was registered on account of a dispute with the proprietor of Amarpali Resort.

The State counsel informs that the petitioner is a married man and the FIR was lodged by the girl to whom there was a promise of marriage and the complainant had approached the petitioner for training of her brother and the petitioner started calling the complainant and later proposed marriage, which the complainant accepted and thereafter he forced himself upon her and took her to different hotels. Later on he refused to marry her. The counsel

says that after the complaint was lodged, the accused gave a message to the complainant to withdraw the case and she was called to Ambala but when she reached Ambala, the petitioner was not there and was dejected she committed suicide. The counsel further states that the girl had made a statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C.

The allegations against the petitioner are serious. Seven witnesses have already been examined. The trial is proceeding. No case for bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
