Regular bail was granted to respondent No.2 on 12.1.2018 in CRM-M No.45100 of 2017, after noticing the fact that no injury was found on the abdomen of Harpal Singh. Eye witnesses, namely, Karam Singh, Dharam Singh and Mangal Singh have not supported the case of the prosecution. Even the complainant, while appearing as PW-7, has not supported the case of the prosecution in his cross-examination. The discrepancy with regard to receipt of injury on the thigh or the abdomen would not advance the case of the complainant at this stage to seek cancellation of bail, which was granted on 12.1.2018 without meaning anything on the merits of the case.

No ground is made out for cancellation of bail.

Dismissed.
