Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents not to harass the petitioner and her son on account of involvement of petitioner's husband in some criminal case.

The husband of the petitioner is an accused under Section 420 IPC. It appears that he is on the run. The police has visited the house of the petitioner in order to nab her husband.

Petitioner alleges violation of her legal rights and invasion of her personal liberties.

Learned counsel submits that she has no objection in case her husband is arrested in a lawful manner but under the garb of such effort, she may not be harassed and humiliated.

Petitioner has also filed a representation before respondent No.3.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing any reply, as no order prejudicial to the interest of either party is being passed.

At this stage, without embarking upon merits of the case, it would be appropriate to ask respondent No.3 to have a fair look on the grievance of the petitioner and pass appropriate order in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.
