P.B.BAJANTHRI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners have sought for quashing of FIR No.140 dated 24.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Section 498-A, 323, 377 IPC registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur, on the basis of compromise dated 31.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of some matrimonial dispute and now it has been resolved among parties.

This Court by the order dated 02.05.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Civil Judge (Jr.Divn.)-cum-Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla has sent his report dated 08.06.2018 wherein it is stated that pursuant to the order of this Court,

statements of the parties have been recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

In view of the law laid down in “*Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab*” 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, petition is allowed and FIR No.140 dated 24.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) under Section 498-A, 323, 377 IPC registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom against the petitioners, are hereby quashed subject to payment of litigation cost of Rs.3000/- by each of the petitioners to State of Punjab. Cost shall be remitted in the Home Department, State of Punjab within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of this order.
