Petitioner is seeking regular bail in case FIR No.0264 dated 20.07.2017 (Annexure P-2) registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submitted that no role was played by the petitioner in respect of money transaction between the complainant and Vikas. The alleged role played by the petitioner is to the extent that petitioner has furnished bank account number. That apart, it was submitted that among the parties, matter has been settled on 11.4.2018 (Annexure P-7).

3. While resisting the claim of the petitioner, learned State counsel submitted that accused cheated the complainant and loss him to the tune of Rs.50,00,000/-. However, he admit the role played by the petitioner.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances and without commenting on the merits of the case, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
