This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 420, 406, 171 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Hisar, vide FIR No.34 dated 10.01.2017.

FIR was registered on the complaint made by Dinesh Kumar son of Ram Karan with the allegations that petitioner in collusion with other co-accused duped new currency notes of Rs.33.00 lacs of the complainant on the pretext of exchanging the same with old currency. Accused after taking new currency notes, fled away with old currency notes instead of handing over the same to the complainant. Investigating agency requires custodial interrogation of the petitioner to know whereabouts of the other co-accused and has also to effect recovery of the amount from him. Besides, petitioner is also involved in nine other cases of similar nature. In

my considered view, custodial interrogation of the petitioner may be necessary to take the investigation to its logical end. Petition is without any merit and is hereby dismissed.
