ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.133 dated 13.05.2010 under Sections 452/427/379/148/149 IPC (subsequently challan presented under Sections 451/427/34 IPC and other Sections were deleted) registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala (Annexure P-1), along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between the parties, which has now been resolved. The matter has been compromised.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 19.01.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Barnala, has sent a report dated 27.03.2018, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between the parties, which has now been resolved.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.133 dated 13.05.2010 under Sections 452/427/379/148/149 IPC (subsequently challan presented under Sections 451/427/34 IPC and other Sections were deleted) registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
