Prayer in this petition is for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No. 014 dated 15.01.2018 under Sections 379-B, 411, 467, 468, 471, 473, 201 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused of the petitioner, who was allegedly arrested on the spot along with the petitioner, has been granted bail vide order dated 31.05.2018 passed in CRM-M-18518 of 2018. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 15.01.2018.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, submits that although the co-accused of the petitioner has been granted bail pending trial, the petitioner is having another case of the similar nature against him.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, considering the facts that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 15.01.2018; co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted bail and the trial is likely to take some time, the present petition is allowed. The

petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his
furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty
Magistrate, concerned.
