ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.168 dated 06.10.2017, registered under Sections 498-A, 304-B and 302 of IPC Act at Police Station Sadar Kharar, District S.A.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 10.07.2017 and 8 witnesses have been examined and all the private witnesses have not supported the prosecution version. Counsel refers to the statements (Annexures P1 to P3).

The complainant and other family members have not supported the prosecution version and were declared hostile. The occurrence had taken place 5 years after marriage. There is a child who is 4 years old and with the family of the petitioner.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
