Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 26.07.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that no recovery has been effected.

Counsel for the petitioner states that it was a simple marriage and no dowry was given.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 26.07.2018

granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
