AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court primarily with a grievance that there are threats being given to them including elimination by respondents 6 to 8 and harassment at the hands of respondent No.5-S.H.O. Police Station Nawanshahr, District S.B.S. Nagar, who calls them at the Police Station and makes them sit all through the day with an intention to humiliate and harass at the behest of private respondents 6 to 8.

It is contended that this act is being done with an intention to force the petitioners to withdraw their complaints, which they had submitted to the police authorities including representation dated 10.04.2018 (Annexure P-6) to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab.

Having considered the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioners and without commenting thereon, it would be open to the petitioners to pursue their representations/legal remedies available to them in accordance with law.

As regards the allegations against respondent No.5-S.H.O. Police Station Nawanshahr, District S.B.S. Nagar, direction is issued to the said respondent to serve a proper notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. in case the petitioners are required on a complaint which is or may have been filed against them.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
