The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life, personal liberty and property of the petitioner and his family members from private respondents; further to take legal action against the private respondents and also not to allow them or anybody else to interfere with the life, liberty and property of the petitioner and his family members.

The direction is sought against respondent No.4-Smt. Jyoti and respondent No.5-Ramji Dass, who are wife and father-in-law of the petitioner respectively, on the ground that on 05.04.2018, they alongwith other persons armed with deadly weapons, entered the house of the petitioner and gave severe beatings to the petitioner and his family members but there is no material on the record to establish if they were given severe beating with deadly weapons.

The petitioner is facing trial in case FIR No.98 dated 11.07.2014, registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, filed by respondent

No.4-Smt. Jyoti. The petitioner is residing in his own village whereas respondent Nos.4 and 5 are residing in Nabha. It seems that the petitioner has abused the process of law.

As such, finding no ground to grant any protection to the petitioner, the instant petition stands dismissed.
