Petitioners have sought for quashing of FIR No.224 dated 31.10.2013 registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 34 IPC at Police Station Guru Har Sahai District Ferozepur on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. Parties have entered into a compromise vide Annexure P-2. This Court by order dated 18.05.2017 directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate for recording their statements with regard to veracity of compromise. It has been recorded by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Guruharsahai and a report in this regard has been sent to this Court vide letter dated 11.01.2018.

3. In view of the law laid down in Narinder Singh v. State of Punjab; 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.224 dated 31.10.2013 registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 34 IPC at

Police Station Guru Har Sahai District Ferozepur alongwith all consequential proceeding arising out of this FIR are hereby quashed subject to payment of litigation cost of Rs.3000/- by each of the petitioner. Cost shall be remitted in the Treasury, State of Punjab, within a period of 2 months from today.
