The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.09 dated 19.1.2018, registered at Police Station Division No.6, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, under Section 409 IPC.

Pursuant to order dated 2.5.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation. It is, however, submitted that recovery of a sum of Rs.1,69,710/- is yet to be effected. During the course of investigation, the petitioner has suffered a disclosure statement that he was the one, who committed the crime.

As per the FIR, apart from the petitioner, there are two other persons against whom allegations have been made. Thus, merely on the basis of disclosure statement of the petitioner, it cannot be said with any amount of certainty that the petitioner was involved in the theft/misappropriation of funds.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 2.5.2018, is made absolute

subject to compliance of conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 by him.
