RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 78 dated 09.04.2018 under Sections 324/323/341/379/148/149 of the IPC at Police Station City Ferozepur District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of settlement/agreement dated 12.04.2018 (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. Vide orders dated 24.07.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court, to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, parties appeared before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur and got recorded their statements qua compromise on 18.09.2018. Report from the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur vide

letter No.363 dated 18.09.2018, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Ferozepur, vide Endst. No. 10809/EB, Dated 20.09.2018, has been received. According to the report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur, the compromise is genuine and it is voluntarily effected between the parties with their free consent and without any pressure, threat, coercion or undue influence from any side.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR No. 78 dated 09.04.2018 under Sections 324/323/341/379/148/149 of the IPC at Police Station City Ferozepur District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioners is quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs. 10,000/-, out of which Rs. 4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana, High Court, Rs. 1000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs. 5,000/- with High Court Legal Services Committee, within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
