The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.5, dated 10.01.2018 registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur, under sections 307, 452, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner caused injuries with his revolver to the complainant and other persons of his family. It is further alleged that he fired shots at others too.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the injuries are on all the non-vital parts of the body and the brother of the petitioner was also injured in the same incident. Regarding that DDR has been registered as cross-case.

There are serious allegations against the petitioner. He appears to be the main accused in this case as he has intentionally caused fire-arm injuries to the complainant and his family members. Thus, he does not deserve the discretionary relief of anticipatory bail

The petition is misconceived and is accordingly dismissed.
