By way of filing this petition, the petitioner Kaka Singh @ Sukhwinder Singh seeks grant of anticipatory bail in a case registered against him vide FIR No.33 dated 1.4.2017 under Sections 326, 324, 323 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Kabarwala, Distirct Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The allegations in nutshell are that on 29.3.2017, when the complainant was present at his home, then at about 10:30 PM, he received a telephonic call from Raju asking him to come outside and when he went outside he saw Kaka Singh armed with '*kirpan*', Jora Singh armed with iron rod and Raju armed with '*dang*' and who attacked him. He alleged that Kaka Singh gave a blow with '*kirpan*', which hit him on fingers of his right hand and thereafter Raju caught hold of him and threw him down and thereafter Raju alongwith Jora inflicted injuries on his back with '*dang*' and iron rod.

Notice of the present petition was issued to the State vide order dated 3.5.2018 and the petitioner was granted interim bail.

Today, at the very outset, the learned State counsel assisted by ASI, Sawinder Singh has stated that the petitioner has since joined investigation and is no longer required for any further investigation.

I further find that the present case is stated to be a case of cross-version, wherein the petitioner has also sustained injuries on his person including an incised wound.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, in my opinion, it is a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The petition, as such, is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 3.5.2018 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
