Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.649 dated 26.06.2017 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused of the petitioner namely Nitin, Vijay Kumar and Dalbir were granted the concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 23.10.2017 passed in CRM-M-28235-2017 and vide order dated 26.02.2018 passed in CRM-M-7278-2018, other co-accused namely Pardeep and Bhateri were also granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dev Kumar, submits that the complainants, who are 42 in number, have already submitted

the affidavit(s) before the Investigating Officer that the amount has been paid back to them.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of and the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 17.05.2018 at 10.00 a.m. or any other date or time as fixed by him, to join the investigation and he shall be released on interim bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds subject to the following conditions: -

- 1. He shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2. He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and*
- 3. He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.*
