LISA GILL, J.

Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No. 34 dated 17.04.2017 under Sections 376, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Valotha, District Tarn Taran alongwith consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Respondent No. 2, it is submitted, had filed CRM-M-19496-2017 seeking protection of life and liberty from her own family members. It was averred therein that respondent No. 2 was compelled to implicate the present petitioners in a false case regarding which a complaint was submitted by her to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran. The said petition was disposed of by this Court on 30.05.2017 (Annexure P-3) with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the representation in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly states that final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 34 has not yet been presented. At this stage, no ground is made out for interference in exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed at this stage.
Needless to say the petitioners are at liberty to bring all these facts to the notice of the investigating agency.
