The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.112 dated 09.04.2015, registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar.

Earlier the petitioner was on bail. On one date, he could not appear, therefore, his bail bonds were cancelled and forfeited to State.

Now the petitioner is stated to have surrendered before the learned trial court in compliance of order dated 03.05.2018 passed by this Court and was granted interim bail.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 03.05.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
