The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.101 dated 06.04.2018, registered under Sections 384, 389, 120-B IPC at Police Station City Sangrur.

The allegations against the petitioners are that they alongwith a lady Harjit Kaur trapped Teja Singh, father of the complainant and duped Rs.30,000/- from the complainant party, by different modes.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sub Inspector Gurmit Singh, has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation, nothing is recovered from them, and they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 03.05.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
