This is a petition for quashing of FIR No.26 dated 19.01.2016, under Sections 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala and the consequent/subsequent proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise dated 20.07.2016 (Annexure P-2).

This court has referred the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre. A compromise has been effected vide Annexure P-2. However, learned counsel for complainant/respondent No.2 has suffered a statement that as per the settlement, the complainant has received Rs.16,50,000/-. She has no objection if FIR No.26 dated 19.01.2016, under Sections 406, 420 IPC registered at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala be quashed and consequently this petition be accepted.

Consequently, this petition is accepted and FIR No.26 dated 19.01.2016, under Sections 406, 420 IPC registered at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala and the consequent/subsequent proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise stands quashed.
