Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for taking lawful action against respondent No.4 who is a serving police official.

Petitioner has pleaded that his son was arrested in a criminal case and thereafter, he was subjected to third degree by the police. In the said context, son of the petitioner may have some actionable right, but under the garb of aforesaid involvement of son of the petitioner, respondent No.4 is harassing the petitioner for no obvious reasons. Petitioner confines his prayer only to the extent of protecting his life and personal liberty from being invaded by respondents No.3 and 4.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from respondent/State as no order prejudicial to the interest of the parties is being passed.

At this stage, this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the representations dated 11.02.2016 and 31.03.2018 (Annexures P1 and P2) made by the petitioner and act in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of facts recorded hereinabove.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
