Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to official respondents to conduct a fair and independent investigation preferably through a gazetted officer not below the rank of Inspector General of Police and to take appropriate legal action against the accused by considering the facts and circumstances as narrated by the petitioner and on the basis of the medical report of the petitioner whereas the local police in order to give undue advantage to respondent No.4 and at his instance has registered a case FIR No.0172 dated 14.12.2017, registered under Sections 323/324 IPC at Police Station Division No.6, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for the relief that the representation dated (Annexure P-2), moved to the Station House Officer, Police Station Division No.6, Jalandhar, by the petitioner be considered and decided in a time bound manner.

In view of above, respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-2)

and decide the same expeditiously preferably within 60 days, as per law, after the receipt of certified copy of this order. However, the investigation be conducted by a lady police officer not below the rank of Inspector General of Police.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
