The present petition has been filed for quashing of cross version recorded vide DDR No.17 dated 26.02.2015, registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, in case FIR No.24 dated 26.02.2015, registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Daresi, District Ludhiana on the basis of compromise.

Pursuant to order dated 03.05.2018, report dated 30.07.2018 has been received from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana (Duty), according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.
