Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.86 dated 09.09.2017 under Sections 420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Cantt Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljeet Pal, submits that the petitioner is in judicial lockup since 06.10.2017 and allegations against the petitioner are that he had entered into an agreement to sell regarding the land, which was mortgaged with the bank and has failed to execute the sale deed. It is further submitted that the challan was presented on 04.12.2017 and charges are yet to be framed.

Though there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, however, considering the fact that the investigation in the case is complete and the petitioner is not more required for further investigation; offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate and it will take some time in conclusion of the trial,

this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

A copy of this order be sent to the trial Court for compliance.

Petition is disposed of.
