The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.20 dated 03.04.2016 registered under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC (offence under Sections 307 and 325 IPC added later on) at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the previous order dated 20.08.2018, the complainant has already been examined before the Court. Therefore, there is no apprehension of tampering of evidence by the petitioner. It is further contended that the co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted bail.

This fact is not denied by counsel appearing for the complainant.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon merits of

the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial on his furnishing bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
