Petitioners-Surinder Pal Singh and Sunita have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.115 dated 12.09.2017, registered at Police Station Julkan, District Patiala, under Sections 302, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that though, the present petitioners are not named in the FIR which was got registered by Harnek Singh (now deceased), but they are named in the statement of sister of Harnek Singh namely Harmesh Kaur, who also received the injuries. As per her statement, petitioner No.1-Surinder Pal Singh caused injuries to the deceased with blunt weapon. She also stated in her statement that petitioner No.2-Sunita also took active participation in the offence by catching hold the deceased etc.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of nature and gravity of the offence and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioners are entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
