MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

The petitioner was given the concession of interim bail vide order dated 09.05.2018 which reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per FIR, 4250 tablets of “Lomotil” were recovered from the petitioner, which were alleged to be a contraband. Report of the FSL has not been received so far, as such, petitioner may be allowed interim bail till report of FSL is received.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mashinder Singh submits that sample of tablets recovered from the petitioner has been sent to FSL but the report is still awaited.

List on 31.07.2018.

Till then, petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/duty Magistrate.”

Thereafter, the matter was heard on 22.10.2018 wherein it is noticed by this Court that the FSL report stands received and resultantly, a direction was issued to the petitioner to surrender on or before 12.11.2018.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State on instructions from ASI Charanjit Singh, has intimated that the petitioner has not surrendered pursuant to directions issued by this Court vide order dated 22.10.2018. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner, no indulgence can be shown. Resultantly, petition stands dismissed.
