Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.62 dated 11.03.2016 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-26, Chandigarh.

The petitioner was granted interim protection vide order dated 08.05.2018. However, vide order dated 16.07.2018, the petitioner was given an opportunity to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate, in case, the Investigating Officer deliberately does not permit the petitioner to join the investigation and that in that eventuality, the Magistrate would ensure that the Investigating Officer investigate the petitioner in the Court premises.

Learned counsel for the State, being instructed by SI Krishan Dev Singh, submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, he has not cooperated in investigation. It is further contended that the Bank draft involved in the case was encashed in an account where the address of the present petitioner is given. It is further pointed out that even the photograph of complainant on the voter cards and the sale deed did not

tally.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to grant bail to the petitioner and, thereby, to prevent the police from conducting custodial interrogation.

Dismissed.
