Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.44 dated 09.04.2017, under Section 406, 498-A, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Sri Mukatsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

It is informed that during the pendency of petition, the parties have amicably resolved their dispute. Photocopy of compromise deed dated 12.12.2017 furnished in Court today, is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Learned counsel submit that petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, has been filed by the petitioner and his wife-respondent no.2. Their statements at first motion have been recorded and part of the settled amount received by respondent no.2. The said petition is informed to be listed for recording of statements of the parties

at second motion on 06.07.2018. Petitioner undertakes to handover the balance amount in terms of the compromise to respondent no.2 on the said date. The parties agree to abide by the terms and conditions of the settlement.

Respondent no.2, it is submitted has no objection in case this petition is allowed subject to the petitioner strictly adhering to the terms and conditions of the settlement.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Pritam Singh, verifies that the petitioner has joined investigation. There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, but without commenting upon or expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Consequently, order dated 18.05.2017, is made absolute.

Liberty is afforded to respondent no.2 to move an appropriate application in this matter in case the terms and conditions of the settlement between the parties are not adhered to by the petitioner.
