Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary direction to respondent No.3 in the context of allegations made by him in the petition.

Petitioner alleged harassment at the hands of his own children. Son of the petitioner namely Kuldeep Singh is in Canada. Respondent No.4 is the daughter of the petitioner. Private respondents in connivance with each other got the petitioner admitted in some illegal drug rehabilitation centre run by respondent No.5. Petitioner remained in illegal confinement of respondent No.5 and was tortured and humiliated while in captivity. He was got released by the intervention of residents of

the village including Jasbir Singh, who timely made a complaint to respondent No.2. Petitioner was got released from illegal confinement of respondent No.5. Petitioner further alleged incriminating allegations against respondent No.3 in collusion with respondent No.6 who happens to be friend of his son Kuldeep Singh.

Precisely, for the grievance in question, petitioner has already made a representation to respondent No.2 keeping in view the alleged overtact attributed to respondent No.3 and other private respondents.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from respondents No.1 to 3 as no order prejudicial to the interest of the parties is being passed.

At this stage, this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the representations dated 23.04.2018 (Annexures P1 and P2) made by the petitioner and act in accordance with law without

being influenced by any statement of facts recorded hereinabove.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
