Petitioner prayed for issuance of necessary direction to respondent No.2 to safeguard her life and personal liberty from being invaded by respondents No.4 and 5.

Petitioner has pleaded in the petition that on 07.03.2018, her house was ransacked by the private respondents and a complaint was made to the police on helpline, but no action was taken. Thereafter, petitioner filed representation on 05.04.2018 before respondent No.2, but no action has been taken till date. Reference to police complaint made on helpline has been duly mentioned by the petitioner in the representation dated 05.04.2018 so filed before respondent

No.2.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

At this stage, this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the representation dated 05.04.2018 made by the petitioner and act in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of facts recorded hereinabove.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
