Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to raise all the pleas before the learned trial Court. However, he has submitted that personal appearance of the petitioners may be exempted and they be permitted to appear through counsel.

Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with permission to the petitioners to raise all the pleas taken in this petition and otherwise available to them before the learned trial Court. As regards the request for exemption from personal appearance of the petitioners, the trial Court shall consider the request sympathetically and may allow them to appear through counsel unless the presence of the petitioners is found to be necessary before the Court.
