This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing orders dated 16.12.2016 (Annexure P-4) passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar vide which discharge application filed by the petitioners stands dismissed as well as the orders passed by Additional District Judge, Amritsar affirming the said order.

By an order dated 18.05.2017, notice had been issued only to the limited extent of exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement and at the time of ordering notice of motion, a sum of ₹ 10,000/- was to be paid to respondent No.3 by the petitioners as litigation/travel expenses. It appears that a compromise between the parties is not possible. A sum of ₹ 10,000/- has been paid on behalf of petitioner No.1 as litigation/travel expenses which has been accepted.

This Court is informed that petitioner No.2 has since expired.

Since notice of motion was issued to the limited extent, no further orders are

called for.

Accordingly, instant petition stands dismissed.
