Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in Complaint No.51263 dated 09.07.2013, titled as 'M/s Goel Trading Company Vs. Varun Kumar', filed under Section 138 of the N.I.Act, pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 16.05.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that trial of case will take a long time and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in this petition, the same is allowed. The order dated 16.05.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
