Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for quashing of PO order dated 27.04.2015 (Annexure P-3) passed by Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mohali in case FIR No.267 dated 16.10.2013 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B, 175 IPC registered at Police Station Phase-1, Mohali. Prayer has also been made for quashing of proclamation proceedings under Section 82 CrPC.
