The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 484 dated 20.12.2017, under Sections 506 IPC and Sections 8 and 10 (added later) of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is a senior citizen being 72 years old, while further submitting that the matter has been compromised. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 21.12.2017 and the trial is likely to take some time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Mr. P.P. Chahar, DAG, Haryana opposes the bail application,

while contending that the offence as alleged to have been committed by the petitioner is of serious nature, however, he is not able to deny the fact that the matter has been compromised.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is a senior citizen of 72 years , the matter has been compromised and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
