This petition under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.155 dated 28.06.2012 (wrongly typed as 28.06.2002 in order dated 04.03.2016) registered under Sections 406, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present FIR and no specific role has been attributed to him. Further, the petitioner has not been named in the FIR.

Heard.

Vide order dated 27.01.2017, the first bail petition of the petitioner was dismissed as withdrawn as the petitioner allegedly had been declared a proclaimed offender. However, later on it transpired that the petitioner was never declared a proclaimed offender. The petitioner has moved another petition i.e. CRM-M-29678-2017 (Annexure P-4) wherein

notice of motion has been issued. Considering the fact that FIR in question was registered in the year 2012 and till date, the petitioner has not submitted himself for investigation and has been successfully evading the process of the Court; very specific role has been attributed to the petitioner, no case for anticipatory bail is made out at this stage.

However, considering the fact that on the statement allegedly made by learned State counsel in CRM-M-11169-2016, the petitioner made a request to withdraw the main petition, therefore, it is ordered that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of ten days from today, his bail application be considered and decided expeditiously by the Court of competent jurisdiction.
