The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0120 dated 12.09.2016 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 307, 323, 324, 458, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kharar and all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise.

In compliance of the order dated 12.11.2018, report dated 17.12.2018 of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kharar received.

After recording of the statements of complainant and the accused, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kharar has reported that parties have entered into compromise and that the same is genuine, voluntarily and out of free will.

In this case, it is alleged that accused entered in the house of the complainant forcibly and caused eight injuries. None of the injury was found to be dangerous to life. The case is stated to be still under investigation.

As parties have effected compromise, the presentation of the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., the trial of the case will be useless exercise as the complainant will not support the prosecution case.

It being so, FIR No.0120 dated 12.09.2016 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 307, 323, 324, 458, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kharar along with all consequential proceedings, stands quashed qua the petitioners.
