The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.0021 dated 21.01.2018, registered under Sections 307, 323, 427, 186, 353, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Division No.7, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he throw stones on the police party with an intention to commit murder due to which one lady constable suffered injuries.

This Court vide order dated 07.05.2018 directed the petitioner to join the investigation but he failed to join the same. In spite of that, two more opportunities were granted to him vide orders dated 28.08.2018 and 22.11.2018 but he did not comply with the aforesaid orders. As such, he is not entitled for the benefit of bail.

Therefore, finding no ground to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, the instant petition stands dismissed.
